



DIRECTIONS FROM NELSPRUIT TO ALL CAMPS

NELSPRUIT TO KARONGWE CAMP

- FROM NELSPRUIT, take the R40 to White River.
- From White River, stay on the R40 towards Hazyview.
- From Hazyview, stay on the R40 heading towards Hoedspruit.
- From Hoedspruit you take the R526 towards Mica/Phalaborwa.
- From Mica, turn left onto the R530.
- After about 23km, turn right onto the R36 towards Tzaneen/Letsitele.
- After another approximately 10km, you will find the Karongwe Spectra Gate on your right hand side.

The instructor will meet all the students at Spectra Gate at 14h00.

NELSPRUIT TO MAKULEKE CAMP

- FROM NELSPRUIT, take the R40 to White River.
- From White River, stay on the R40 towards Hazyview.
- From Hazyview, stay on the R40 heading towards Hoedspruit.
- From Hoedspruit you take the R526 towards Mica/Phalaborwa.
- You then take the 'turn off' to Gravelotte (sign says Tzaneen).
- Carry on straight in the direction of Letsitele/Tzaneen.
- You will then get to a STOP (if you turn left, you go to Letsitele). Carry on straight. About 300m after the STOP, you will see a sign saying Giyani (R529) to your right. Turn right towards Giyani.
- Drive straight through Giyani.
- From there you will start finding signs indicating Punda Maria. Follow them until you reach the Kruger National Park and the Punda Maria gate. Enter there.

- From there you continue for about 21km, until you find the turn off to Pafuri gate. There you turn left in the direction of Pafuri and keep on straight until you reach Pafuri gate.

You will meet the instructor at Pafuri Gate at 14h00 on the first day of the course.

NELSPRUIT TO SELATI CAMP

- FROM NELSPRUIT, take the R40 to White River
- From White River, stay on the R40 towards Hazyview
- From Hazyview, stay on the R40 heading towards Hoedspruit.
- From Hoedspruit you take the R526 towards Mica/Phalaborwa.
- You then take the 'turn off' to Gravelotte (sign says Tzaneen)
- Continue along this road for 23km. The main entrance to the Selati Reserve will be on your right

Our instructor will meet you at 14h00 at Selati main gate office, as no private vehicles are allowed down to the camp.
